

Detailed selection criteria for “*Prabashwara*” Scholarship Program  
Faculty of Livestock Fisheries & Nutrition

Scholarships shall be awarded to **needy** students of the Faculty on the following criteria.

- i) Recipient students should be an internal undergraduate of Faculty of Livestock, Fisheries and Nutrition of the Wayamba University of Sri Lanka.
- ii) Parent’s income level should be below the eligible income level to be decided by the Scholarship Committee. Any student applicant not qualified for scholarship will have to right to appeal to the Faculty Board for further consideration.
- iii) For continuing the scholarship the academic performance of the candidate should be considered and the Grade Point Average of the eligible student should be 2.0
- iv) If the scholarship is discontinued due to drop of GPA below 2 upon the request of the student scholarship can be continued if the requirements are fulfilled
- v) Scholarship winner should sit at least 80% of the relevant examinations after winning the scholarship and he/she should perform up to the satisfactory level, if not the scholarship will be discontinued.
- vi) Scholarship Committee has the authority to withdraw the scholarship depending on disciplinary ground; their decision shall be final and conclusive.
- vii) Any student whose scholarship has been terminated will have the right to appeal to the Faculty Board.
